Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building 8 projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September 9 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements. 10 11 A mandatory pre-bid tour is scheduled for April 15, 2024 and April 16, 2024 at 9:00am at the site, 30 N Carroll Street, Madison WI. The conference and walk-through is scheduled for the purpose of acquainting 12 13 prospective bidders with the site conditions of the project.
