The controls currently are past 39 their useful life and will be upgraded to a standalone DDC controls with the actuation being electric due to the 40 existing air compressor is not operating at 100% capacity. The existing lighting in the mechanical room is being 41 upgraded to LED type fixtures and the new air handling unit will require power connections to the unit.
