20 who are not certified will be rejected. **These changes take effect January 1, 2014.** Contractor

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30 In general, the work consists of: **Rebuild two chillers at chiller plant and one chiller at**
31 **University Center.**

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33 Construction bidding documents (drawings, specifications and addenda) may be obtained only
34 as downloadable electronic files (in PDF format) from the Division of Facilities Development
35 website. Construction bidding documents may also be available at various Builders' Exchanges.
36 Additional project construction bidding information, including plan holders list, is available on the
37 DFD website. Please note that a WisBuild login and password are required to download bidding
38 documents. Interested parties may request a WisBuild login and password at the DFD website
39 – allow 2 days to process login and password requests.

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41 **The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's**
42 **prevailing wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements**
43 **on state building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects**
44 **advertised for bid after September 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal**
45 **Davis Bacon Act requirements.**
