The entrances and door assemblies have been evaluated 38 to identify deficiencies, develop design solution alternatives, and recommend appropriate corrective measures. 39 Project also includes replacement of five exterior door assembly entrances on the Science Building to the East. 40 It includes labor and material costs for the removal and disposal of the existing doors and frames and 41 installation of the new doors and frames. 42
