These successful MEP bids must be included in all general prime contractor 27 bids received. No later than 5 days after DFD identifies the successful MEP bids, DFD will publicly open 28 general prime contractor bids. General prime contractor bids that do not include the successful MEP 29 bids will be rejected. The bidder is responsible for the sealed 35 bid being delivered to the indicated location for receipt stamping before the time specified for the bid opening. 36 Third party delivery is entirely at the bidder's risk. 37 38 In general, the work consists of furnishing and installing two air handlers with emergency power 39 backup to pressurize stairwells X00B and X00D from the 19th floor to the third floor. Provide two 40 heating-only air handling systems to temper the air to 40 degrees F. Extend ductwork and diffusers 41 throughout stairwells. Core stairwell landings and provide stairwell landing reinforcement as 42 necessary.
